Conferees in China

Visa

Visas are required for some nationalities to travel to China for this conference. Please contact your travel agent and/or the Chinese Consulate/Embassy in your country for exact details and visa application procedures as soon as possible. Visa processing times can vary.

Participants are highly recommended to apply for Tourist Visa and other kind of visa; the organizing committee of IDDST 2009 will not issue official letters of invitation due to the new Chinese regulations

Weather

According to the weather forecasting: the average temperature during the period of conference is 6-20°C, the Autumn is already beginning, and it's windy. Jeans and a sweater are usually enough.

Currency

The official currency is the Renminbi (CNY) or Yuan. Chinese money cannot be exported. Major credit cards are accepted (VISA, MASTERCARD), and foreign currency can be converted in airport, hotels, in friendly stores and in subsidiaries of the Bank of China. The working hour of most foreign exchange centre is: 08:30-16:30. You are highly advised to exchange some Renminbi for your bus/taxi fares before your departure. The exchange rate between U.S. dollar and RM

Yuan is approximately at 1: 6.9 (it differs every day). Usually, \$ 200-300 would be enough for your transportation fees, if you would like to buy some souvenirs, \$1000 would be sufficient. Though major credit cards are accepted at big stores and ATMs; cash is still more widely used.

Electricity

A variety of electrical outlets can be found in China and an all-around adaptor set is recommended. Voltage in China is 220V 50Hz. If you will need to use an adapter, please be sure to use an appropriate transformer as well.

Mobile Phone Network

Cellular phones are widely used in China with networks of GSM (800 MHz, 900 MHz & 1800 Mhz) and CDMA.

Working language

The working language of this conference is English, therefore, simultaneous interpretation will not be provided

Cancellation and Refund Policy

Cancellations of registration can only be refunded if the cancellation is made on or before March 1, 2009. All refunds after this date up to June 1, 2009 are subject to 30% administration fee that will automatically be deducted from your

China is in one time zone – Beijing Time (GMT+ 8 hours).

B. Working Hours

Most business organizations are open at 09:00~18:00, government departments at 08:00~17:00, and banks at 09:00~16:30. Working week runs from Monday to Friday. Many stores stay open 12 hours a day, 7 days a week.

Shanghai
